GUIDELINES AND MORE

Guidelines

- Shoe boxes cannot exceed 14x8x5"
- No flammable materials to be lit on fire. Candles may be used as a decorative piece only.
- Food items must be in packaging or wrapped
- Drink items must have a lid
- Placing items outside the shoebox is permitted, judging will only focus on contents within the box.
- Altars are to be constructed at home or at Teatro.

Gift card prizes will be awarded to winners in the age groups of 6-8 and 9-12

- Construction paper
- Paint
- Scissors
- Photo of deceased loved one
- Loved one's favorite items
- Candles
- Marigolds
- Perforated paper
- Small glass with water

- Glue
