Conceived on July 9, 1982, El Teatro De Artes De Juan Seguin (Teatro) was formed as a non-profit, tax-exempt 501 C (3) organization to address several civic issues including the general population's lack of knowledge about the Seguin Mexican American community's history and cultural traditions; the lack of local agencies through which Mexican American leadership potential could be identified, encouraged, and developed; and the lack of Mexican American participation in the general community's sociocultural activities.

To address these concerns, El Teatro established major goals: (1) to ensure Mexican Americans & Latinx know their history, roots and contributions (scholarship, art and leadership); (2) to promote a better understanding of the Mexican American & Latinx people, their history and their culture; and (3) to ensure they feel valued and are made "whole" by discovering their own history which has been neglected.

Teatro and its constituents view history, arts and culture as having to do with values i.e., with the way individuals see, understand and act upon the world. Teatro studies, documents and preserves (but is not limited to) the history, culture and art in the areas of family and history; language; crafts; folklore & folklife; celebrations; foods/culinary; oral tradition; mariachi/ conjunto and other ethnic music; visual arts; dramatic arts; film & video arts; danza folklórica (folklórica dances); and others. All of these are aimed toward "remembering" (reacquisition) lost cultural practices and toward incorporating those practices into everyday life.

#### Since its founding, Teatro **accomplishments** include:

Yearly ballet folklórico, vocalista, conjunto and mariachi music classes. Teatro's Ballet Folklórico De La Rosa & Mariachi Juan Seguin. Annual Noche De Gala, a cultural evening of mariachi music, ballet folklórico dancing, and the amateur vocalista competition. Annual celebrations of National Hispanic Month & Texas Hero Juan Seguin Memorials. Diez y Seis & Cinco de Mayo lectures, exhibits, event & performances. Viva Seguin! Conjunto Festivals. De Mano a Mano Artisan Fairs. Artist-in-Education and Visiting Artists residencies in public school districts. Annual Dia De Los Muertos festivities. Annual Summer Arts and Agroecology Camp.Poetry & Prose sessions. Humanities lectures, exhibits and reflections. Jobs and opportunities for artists, poets, lecturers, historians in schools and in the community. Programs focused on developing young Hispanic artists and leaders. Hispanic plays/drama presentations. Featured in the Heritage series, which aired nationwide through PBS affiliates. Featured in the City of Seguin, United Way and National Endowment for the Arts videos. City of Seguin Downtowner of the Year Award. Approved by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) as an Afterschool Centers.

#### **Mission Statement**

The mission of **Teatro De Artes De Juan Seguin** is to promote a better understanding of the Mexican-American culture by the teaching, study, practice, and performance of the arts. **Teatro De Artes De Juan Seguin** shall support, but not be limited to, the following activities to achieve its mission: (1) Establish and maintain a Ballet Folklórico; (2) Support the formation of Mariachi & Conjunto groups; (3) Sponsor artistic workshops; (4) Sponsor speakers; (5) Sponsor Fiestas Patrias; (6) Sponsor Noche De Gala annually; (7) Involve the community people in drama and other artistic roles; (8) Sponsor Hispanic artist; (9) Support civic, community, business, and education collaboratives to promote the Hispanic arts.

#### **Organizational Goals**

**Teatro De Artes De Juan Seguin** shall: (1) Strive for excellence with its on-going programs; (2) Create a positive image of the Mexican-American people; (3) Keep the culture and pride alive; (4) Educate people of all ages to accept different cultures; (5) Support Hispanic and other artists; (6) Provide opportunities for individuals to develop their artist talents; (7) Provide educational activities to further the community's economic development.

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# Goals of the Ballet Folklórico De La Rosa Program

### The goals are as follows:

- ✓ to study, teach and preserve the history of traditional Mexican-American culture.
- ✓ to study the folklore and folklife of Mexican-Americans and their contributions.
- ✓ to study the roots, origins and history of the danzas folklóricas and how they relate to their
  present lives.
- ✓ to provide internships, fellowships, jobs and leadership opportunities.
- ✓ to promote pride in the Mexican-American history, culture and arts.
- ✓ to promote unity in groups.
- ✓ to provide equal opportunities for all.

## Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

Parent/Guardian should become as involved with their child's folklórico dance class as the child himself/herself.

#### Parents/Guardians should:

- ✓ help the child understand the goals of this program.
- ✓ supervise the child's daily practice.
- √ help him/her understand the commitment of dancing with a group.
- ✓ get him/her to class on time.
- ✓ get him/her to the performances on time.
- ✓ make sure the child has all necessary costume pieces.
- ✓ make sure that everything is clean and pressed, with shined boots and/or shoes.
- ✓ serve on the steering committee.
- ✓ plan, organize, and work during fundraisers.
- ✓ plan, organize, and help during the annual recital.

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#### Ballet Folklórico De La Rosa-Class Rules and Tuition Fees

- 1. Classes start and end on time. There is no childcare supervision provided before or after the dance classes, therefore, BE PROMPT when picking up your child.
- 2. Dance classes meet every MON or WED at Teatro's Cultural Arts Center.
- 3. If a student is absent an excessive amount of days, the student may be dropped from class. Excessive amount of days is defined as two or more per month or a total of 6 per year.
- 4. Tuition is as described below. This hourly fee schedule for families apply only if the persons involved are blood relatives and live in the same household.
- 5. The monthly tuition fee is the same regardless of the number of classes in a month.
- 6. The monthly tuition fee must be paid in full even when a student is absent from class one or more times during that month.

Additional students are \$15 for the first class and \$10 for each additional class.

- 7. TUITION IS DUE THE FIRST CLASS SESSION OF EACH MONTH. Please pay on time either by cash, check or debit/credit card. Tuition fees are needed to pay teachers and other expenses such as utilities, custodial, etc. A \$5.00 late fee will be added to any account delinquent more than sixty (60) days.
- 8. A \$25 fee will be collected during registration in August of each year. This \$25 will be used for the annual recital (costume, accessories, decoration, rent, etc.) expenses. This \$25 fee is non**refundable** and must be paid on/or before the student begins his/her classes.
- 9. Ballet students must be at least 5 years old. If a student shows talent/promise and is under 5 years old, he/she may be accepted into the program on a trial basis. This means: he/she can attend for a month (4 weeks). At the end of the 4 weeks, the Ballet instructor(s) will decide whether the student is capable of remaining in the program. If the student remains in the program, the student must pay the registration fee and tuition fees retroactively.

- 10. Girls' hair must be pulled back and away from the face either in a ponytail or bun. For performances, hair must be worn in a bun (no bangs). Long haired boys will also need to have their hair up and out of their face.
- 11. Girls must wear vibrantly solid colored practice skirts (Lime Green, Blue, Red, etc.). Solid black skirts are acceptable. Boys & girls must wear dance shoes and/or boots to practice every class.
- 12. INTERMEDIATE I, II, III and ADVANCED CLASS STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO BE DRESSED IN ALL BLACK (with the exception of the skirt which can be of vibrant solid colors or black) AT ALL REHEARSALS. Boys and Girls will be dressed in a comfortable black top and black bottom either leggings, sweat pants or athletic shorts. NO JEANS ARE TO BE WORN.
  - **ATTENTION BEGINNER I, II, and III PARENTS**: Beginning in the 2021-2022 year, ALL BEGINNER CLASSES WILL ALSO BE REQUIRED TO DRESS IN ALL BLACK (with the exception of the skirt which can be of vibrant solid colors or black). We encourage you to start wearing MOSTLY all black to practice.
- 13. Due to the pandemic and in the interest of public safety/health, parents, visitors & others are not allowed in the Center until further notice. During normal times, parents/guardians are invited to observe their child's progress the first Monday or Wednesday of each month. This gives parents/guardians the opportunity to see what his/her child is learning. Should you have any questions during the year concerning your child's class, please bring them to the attention of the instructor immediately after class that day. Included in this packet, you will find a COVID-19 release form that must be signed & returned to the Program Coordinator prior to the classes.
- 14. NO TENNIS SHOES OR SANDALS ARE ALLOWED. Student wearing tennis shoes to practice will be allowed to sit and observe the class. If this continues to occur frequently, the instructor and secretary/ registrar will ask the student to call the parent/guardian to either be picked up or bring shoes/boots.
- 15. If you are a student enrolling for the first time and you have any questions, please contact the Program Coordinator. We require new students to have their practice skirts by October 7<sup>th</sup> and their shoes by November 4th. You may wear shoes with a hard sole, but remember- NO TENNIS SHOES OR SANDALS ARE ALLOWED.
- 16. Gum chewing and/or eating by the student during dance practice is NOT allowed.
- 17. Dancers will NOT be allowed to perform unless they are in the proper costume (all costume pieces) and make-up, including footwear and hairstyle.
- 18. All graduating seniors are given the option of a solo or ensemble at the end of year recital. Please contact the Executive Director (Yvonne De La Rosa) no later than Nov. 6 to start the discussion of solo and/or ensemble.

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#### Ballet Folklórico De La Rosa Regulations

- 1. If applicable, dance costume & accessories will be purchased with fundraiser and/or performance monies. These will be the property of TEATRO and will be used by other students in future years.
- 2. Every family is expected to participate in the fundraisers (sell tickets, donate food/goods, donate money, work serving and cleaning shifts, etc.) as these funds will be used for the designated purposes that will benefit the students. For example: If a family is given a certain number of tickets, they must either sell them all and/or purchase them themselves.
- 3. If desired, a steering committee made up of a chair person, one secretary, 1 treasurer, and room mothers for each class will exist. The officers of the Ballet Folklórico De La Rosa will be responsible for keeping all parents/guardians and students informed and will hold monthly meetings (if needed) with all parents/guardians. The officers will plan and implement all fundraisers, annual recital and will assist during performances. This committee will send its recommendations, via Teatro's Program Coordinator, to the regularly scheduled quarterly Teatro Board of Directors Meetings.
- 4. All costumes will need to be returned in good condition. "Good Condition" will be determined by the Costume Coordinator and/or the Costume Coordinator and/or Ballet's secretary/registrar. If the costumes needs to be cleaned or mended, the charge will be paid by the parent or guardian/student.
- 5. If the costumes are not returned, the parents/guardians and students are responsible for paying the full price of the costume(s) to Teatro De Artes De Juan Seguin.
- 6. The outfits belonging to TEATRO will be used -- ONLY --during Teatro-sponsored BALLET bookings.
- 7. Bookings will be made through Teatro's Program Coordinator.
- 8. Coordination of important announcements, updates and polls taken for prospective performances will be made by the Program Coordinator and will be facilitated using the Remind App. Please download the Remind App by Wednesday, October 28 and find your students class code in the Welcome Memo you received in the mail.
- 9. Donations for performances will be set rates of \$250 (in town) 1-30 minutes; \$400 (in town) for 31 minutes to one hour; \$300 (out of town within a 40 mile radius) 1-30 minutes; and \$450 (out of town within a 40 mile radius) for 31 minutes to one hour; and \$100.00 for each additional one-half hour, with a minimum charge of \$250. Performances outside of a 40 mile radius will be priced differently and will be set by the Executive Director.
- 10. Eighty-five percent (85%) of donations earned through this group will be deposited to the Ballet's Dance Accessories Account. This eight-five percent (85%) will be spent on costumes, dance accessories, utilities and other expenses as approved by Teatro's Board of Directors. The other fifteen percent (15%) will be used to purchase music and/or other necessary media, copies, office supplies; and other overhead expenses.
- 11. The Ballet may hold fundraisers whose revenues will be deposited to the Ballet Fundraiser Account. Before planning a fundraiser, A GOAL MUST BE STATED AS TO HOW THE MONEY RAISED WILL BE USED. All fundraisers must be approved by Teatro's Board of Directors. Fundraiser monies will be spent one hundred percent (100%) on Ballet Folklórico students, costumes, and related projects.
- **12.** Auditorium fees for the recital and photo expenses (group pictures) will be paid primarily with registration fees and/or from the Ballet Performance and Ballet Fundraiser Accounts.

## 2020-2021 SAFETY PROTOCOL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE BALLET FOLKLÓRICO DE LA ROSA & MARIACHI JUAN SEGUIN

Teatro De Artes De Juan Seguin will be implementing a plan for entering and exiting the building during practices and other safety protocols. All students and parents are to follow this plan to ensure everyone's continued safety and good health.

- Teatro staff and students are required to wear face coverings and/or masks for the duration of time in the Teatro Cultural Arts Center building. Face masks must be put on before entering the building.
- 2. Drop-off for your student will be at the front doors, please wait in your car for us to conduct a temperature check of your child. We will wave you on should all check out ok.
- 3. Inside of Teatro social distancing practices will be enforced. Students will be able to spread out amongst the 3 rooms at Teatro during all practices and/or the use of the outside Plataforma will also be available.
- 4. Pick up of your student will be at the west side door of the Teatro building by the historic Plataforma.
- 5. Students are to bring their own water bottles filled with water and their name must be on their bottle.
- 6. Parents are to drop off and pick up their student ONLY. The only people that will be allowed in Teatro at one time will be the student, instructor and Teatro staff.
- 7. Tuition will be accepted in the following form:
  - a. Pay over phone by debit and/or credit card
  - b. Tuition check can be made out to Teatro De Artes and please give the check to your child to bring into the center to be received and receipted.
  - c. Exact cash payment can also be made, have your child bring the cash into Teatro and we will receipt your payment.
